Y3/4 Museum Trip – Wednesday 3rd May 2017

The school is proposing to undertake a trip to The Collection in Lincoln to link in with our work on the Anglo-Saxons and has provisionally booked 90 places.

In order to run the trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £9.30 to cover the cost (we have already deducted £1.20 per child which the P.T.F.A. have kindly donated). This contribution will therefore cover the remaining cost of entry, a workshop for the children to make an artefact to keep and transport.

Unfortunately, more and more contributions have gone unpaid for recent trips and St. Michael's simply cannot continue to subsidise the shortfall. Therefore, if we do not receive sufficient contributions by Friday 21st April, the trip will have to be cancelled.

We hope to leave Louth at **9.00am prompt** and return in time for the end of the normal school day.

All children will need a packed lunch. Children in receipt of free school meals can have a packed lunch provided **upon request** – please contact the school office **before Friday 21st April** or we will assume that you would rather provide your own. If you have already pre-paid for a meal on the date of the trip, the cost of this will be refunded to your school money account.

The children will be expected to wear school uniform as normal. Could we request no sweets, electrical equipment or toys etc. on the bus please? Children may bring spending money for the gift shop to a maximum of £5.00.
