### CURRICULUM SWIMMING

Your child will start swimming after half term on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February. Swimming for this academic year will continue in mixed groups. We have been advised by the Meridian Leisure Centre that the entrance fee will remain at £1.90 per week until further notice. There is no cost for the swimming tuition as this expense is met through the school budget.

Lessons will be led by a Meridian Centre level two swimming teacher and St. Michael's staff will also be poolside or in the pool.

Children will swim for a 6 week period (24<sup>th</sup> February, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> March). Unfortunately, in recent years, more and more contributions have gone unpaid for swimming lessons and school simply cannot continue to subsidise the shortfall. Please therefore make your contribution in full (£11.40) at the beginning of your child's group if at all possible.

Therefore, you will need to pay by logging online at [www.schoolmoney.co.uk](http://www.schoolmoney.co.uk) If you have any questions, please contact the school. Should you not have access to the internet at home, please feel free to come into school to use our computer and we can offer any help where needed.**

Swimming is part of the national curriculum and children cannot choose not to go. If, due to health reasons you do not wish your child to attend please send a written letter explaining why.

Please ensure your child has their swimming kit (including goggles) in school on the above dates and that they have a waterproof coat and suitable footwear as they will be walking to the pool.

Could we please also remind you that children must not swim if they have had sickness or diarrhoea in the week prior to the lesson.
