TEAM TRIATHLON FUNDRAISER

We do not hold these events very often as we are conscious of the amount we ask from parents to contribute during the year, but we are having, what we hope will be, a fun sponsored event to raise money for our school funds. The 'School Fund' helps pay for all those little extras like: our Christmas tree, presents & parties; on entry school bookbags; gift of a Leavers' Bibles for Year 6, enrichment activities, prizes and lots more.

Following on from the Olympic success of Team GBs 'Brownlee Brothers', we have decided to try to create a 'Triathlon' with a difference!
