## Y2 Woodside Falconry Trip – Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2017

The school is proposing to undertake a trip to Woodside Falconry at Langworth on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2017 and has provisionally booked 45 places.

In order to run the trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £9.80 to cover the cost (we have already deducted £1.20 per child which the P.T.F.A. have kindly donated). This contribution will therefore cover the remaining cost of entry, a workshop for the children and transport.

Unfortunately, more and more contributions have gone unpaid for recent trips and St. Michael's simply cannot continue to subsidise the shortfall. Therefore, if we do not receive sufficient contributions by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June, the trip will have to be cancelled.

We hope to leave Louth at **9.00am prompt** and return in time for the end of the normal school day.

**All children will need with them is a packed lunch and an extra water bottle.** Children in receipt of free school meals can have a packed lunch provided **upon request** – please contact the school office **before Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June** or we will assume that you would rather provide your own.

The children will be expected to wear their school uniform as normal with trainers. Dependent on the weather, children should bring a waterproof coat and sun hat. Please apply suntan cream before the trip.

If you are able to accompany the staff and children on this trip please advise the school office as soon as possible. We will advise any volunteers nearer the time if their kind offer has been accepted.
