Dear Parent/Carer(s),

End of Year/School trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park – Monday 17th July 2017

It is with great pleasure that I can now confirm details of our end of year/school trip: The Yorkshire Wildlife Park in Doncaster has been booked for Monday 17th July 2017. **The coach will leave at 9.15 am prompt so please could you ensure that your child arrives at school no later than 9 am and we will be back at approximately 5.15 pm.**

The children **do not** need to wear school uniform for this trip however, due to the possibility of changeable weather, please can we ask that you send your child in appropriate clothing (no strappy tops) and sensible footwear must be worn as there is a lot of walking (e.g. please think carefully about whether certain style sandals are appropriate). There will be the opportunity for the children to go on the indoor play area but some slides require socks, long trousers and sleeves so if your child would like to go on these then they may need to bring extra clothing. We also ask that the children are prepared for the possibility of changeable weather and bring a rucksack, waterproof jacket, sun hat and sun cream as they will be outside for most of the day.

All children will need with them is a packed lunch and an extra water bottle. Children in receipt of free school meals can have a packed lunch provided **upon request** – please contact the school office **before Wednesday 28th June** or we will assume that you would rather provide your own.

As the cost of the coach has been covered, we are able to offer the trip at a cost of just £5 per child. Please log onto www.schoolmoney.co.uk using your unique password by Monday 3rd July to give consent for the trip and make payment.

If your child suffers with travel sickness then please make sure they have a tablet in the morning and bring written consent plus another tablet for the return journey.

The children have worked extremely hard this year and we feel that this is a great way of rewarding that hard work and also a fitting way to celebrate their time at St Michael's.
